IT'S YOUR **RIGHT** TO FIX WHAT'S **WRONG**


Election Day: Tuesday, November 5, 2019

Last day to register or change your voting information is
Monday, October 7 by 4 PM


 **Only 17?** If you will be 18 years old on or before November 5 (Election Day), you must register now to vote. Once registered, Jefferson County Clerk will verify your registration via mail.


 **Polls open at 6 AM and close at 6 PM.** If you are in line at 6 PM, you are allowed to vote. Daylight Saving Time ends on Sunday, November 3!


 **What to bring:** Valid ID (bring one of the following): driver's license, U.S. government-issued identification card, credit card, or another form of ID containing both picture and signature.

 **Hard of hearing or vision impaired?** Every polling place has new touchscreen voting machines – BUT they are kind of hidden so you may have to ask for them.

 **Need a ride to polls on Election Day?** The A. Philip Randolph Institute (502.774.4834) provides free rides, or call your local party headquarters.

 **Too sick to vote?** Simply request a paper absentee ballot between Tuesday, October 22 and Tuesday, November 5 by calling the Board of Elections office (502.574.6100) to receive an Emergency Medical Ballot and instructions for completion.

 **Mailed-in Absentee Ballot:** Your application for an absentee ballot must be requested, completed, and returned to the Jefferson County Election Center office no later than close-of-business on Tuesday, October 29 to receive a ballot.

 **Need to vote early?** You're eligible for Early In-House Absentee voting if on Election Day: you will be out-of-town; you are in the last trimester of pregnancy; you or your spouse is scheduled to have surgery; or due to age, illness, or disability you're unable to go to the polls.
