General Election

Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2020

Deadline to register, update and/or check your registration is:

4 PM on Monday, October 5, 2020.

If a person will be 18 years of age ON or before the General Election Day (Tuesday, Nov. 3), he/she must register now to be able to vote in this election.

Sample ballots will be available about four weeks prior to the election from your County Clerk's office.

Vote by one of three ways:

- 1) In-person before Election Day; locations to be determined.
Tuesday, Oct. 13 – Monday, Nov. 2
During regular business hours, and at least four hours on Saturdays, Oct. 17, 24 and 31.
Voters who feel safe voting in person are encouraged to do so before November 3, to ensure that appropriate social distancing can be maintained.
- 2) In-person on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 3. Polls open at 6 AM and close at 6 PM. If you are in line at 6 PM, you are allowed to vote.
- 3) By absentee ballot; to be returned by mail or ballot drop boxes, locations to be finalized.

Mailed in Absentee Ballots

Anyone can request an absentee ballot for this election. Apply at: **GoVoteKY.com**

The deadline to apply online for an Absentee ballot is Friday, October 9, 2020 no later than 11:59 p.m. EDT.

The actual ballot is mailed to the voter. NOTE the ballot has specific requirements of where to sign, fold, etc. Read VERY carefully. Statewide, over 15,000 absentee ballots were rejected because of error; in Louisville, 8381 ballots were rejected, most because of no voter signature.
